



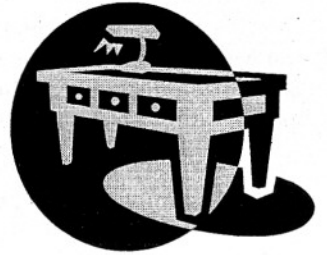

Christmas Social



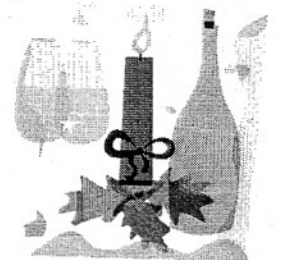
On Thursday, December 28th we had our business meeting and Christmas Social. What a turn-out, it was great to see all our
