7. Say the "Glory be to the Father" and the "Fatima Prayer."
8. Announce the second mystery, then say the "Our Father." Repeat 6 and 7, and continue with the third, fourth, and fifth mysteries in the same manner.
9. Say the "Hail Holy Queen."
10. Say the "Prayer After the Rosary."

5. **The Finding of Jesus in the Temple.** (Love of Jesus and His Teachings)

1. **The Agony in the Garden.** (Contrition, Fervor in Prayer)
2. **The Scourging at the Pillar.** (Patience in Suffering)
3. **The Crowning with Thorns.** (Mortification)
4. **The Carrying of the Cross.** (Patience)
5. **The Crucifixion.** (Self Sacrifice for the Love of God)
