I am ready to do my part in ending abortion.

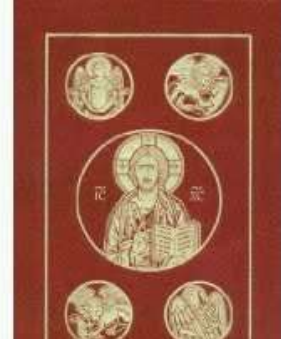
Today I commit myself
